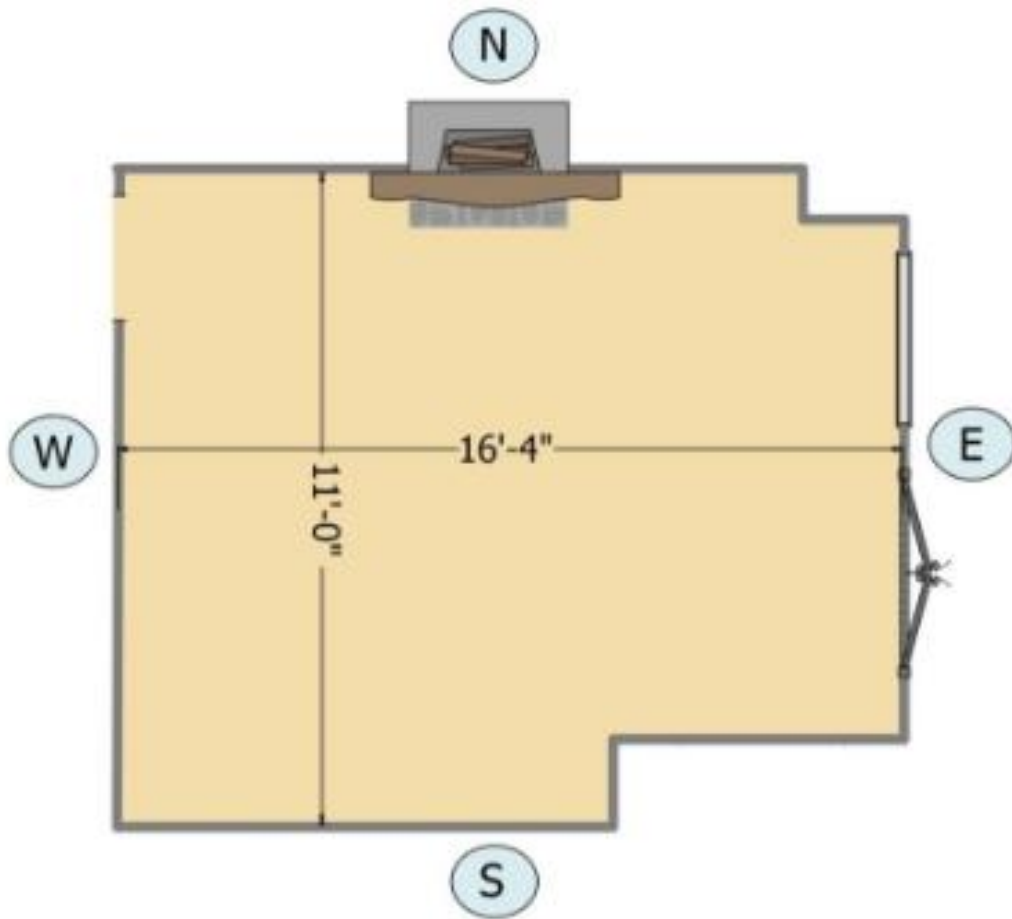




How to measure and photograph your space

Step 1 Draw Floorplan

- Get a pencil and an A4 piece of paper. Sketch your room, don't worry if its not to scale or not perfect.
- Label each wall as either North, South, East and West. Don't know which is which? The sun rises in the East and sets in the West. You can use a Compass App on your phone to help you figure out which is which.
- Now that you have the shape of the room, measure it in meters and centimeters, or if you're comfortable to do so you can measure the room in millimeters. Just make sure you let indicate which unit of measure you are using.

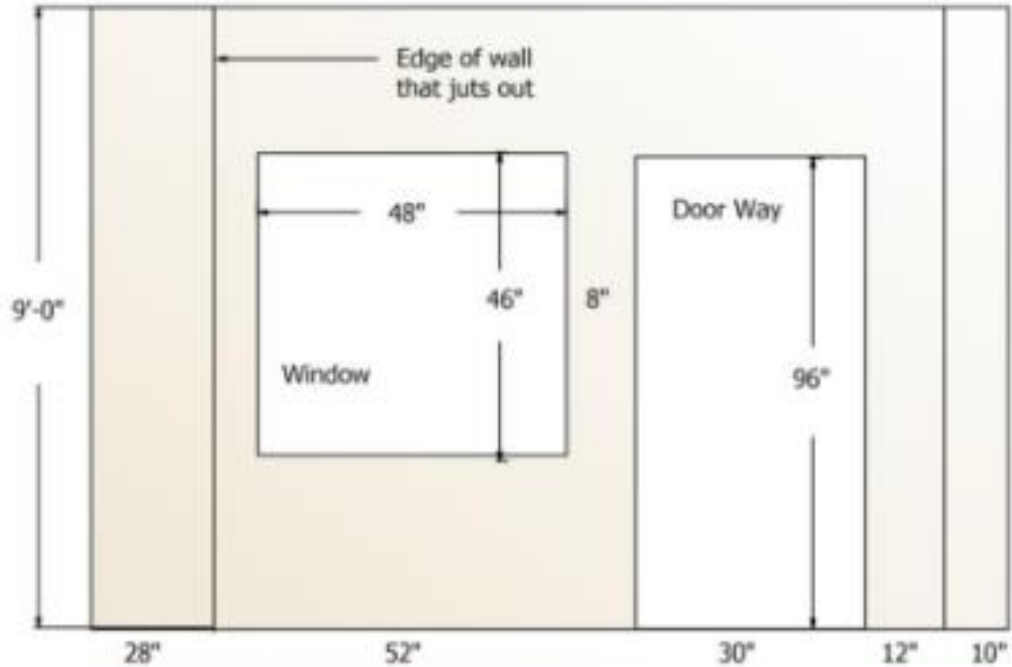


Step 2 Draw Walls

- Draw a rectangle for your wall. Measure each wall in meters and centimeters or millimeters indicating used unit of measure.
- Write in the height and the width of the wall.
- Let me know if it is the North, South, East or West wall.

- Please repeat steps 2, 3 and 4 for each wall.

Step 3 Draw Features

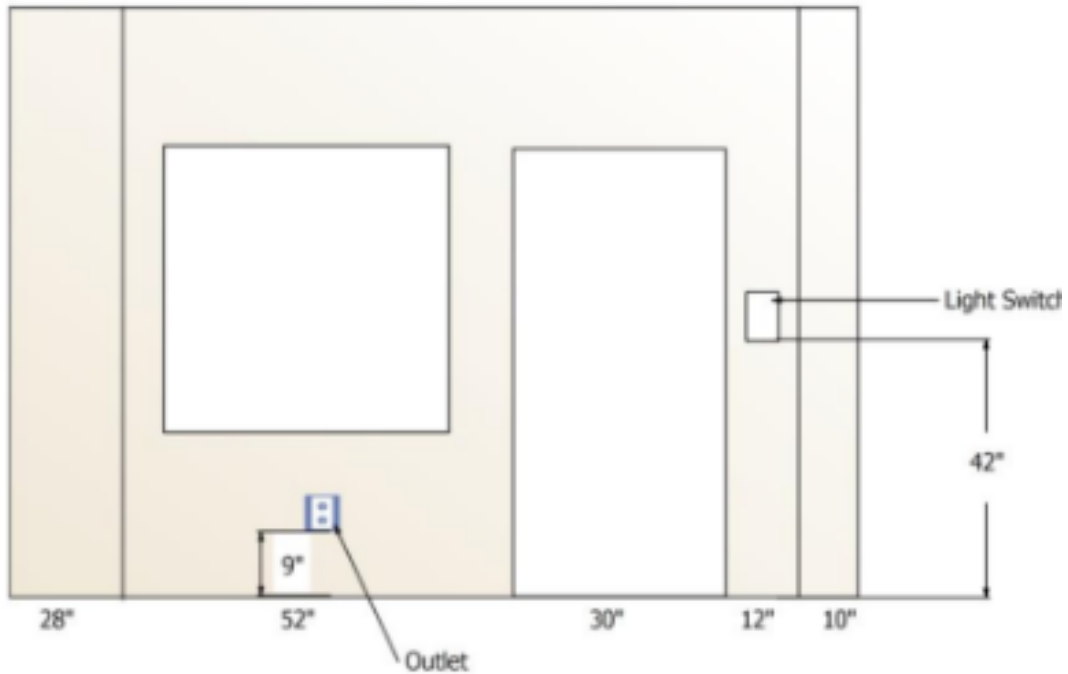


- Draw the features like windows, Doors, fireplaces.
- You need to measure each section of the wall and placement of features.
- Please repeat steps 2, 3 and 4 for each wall.

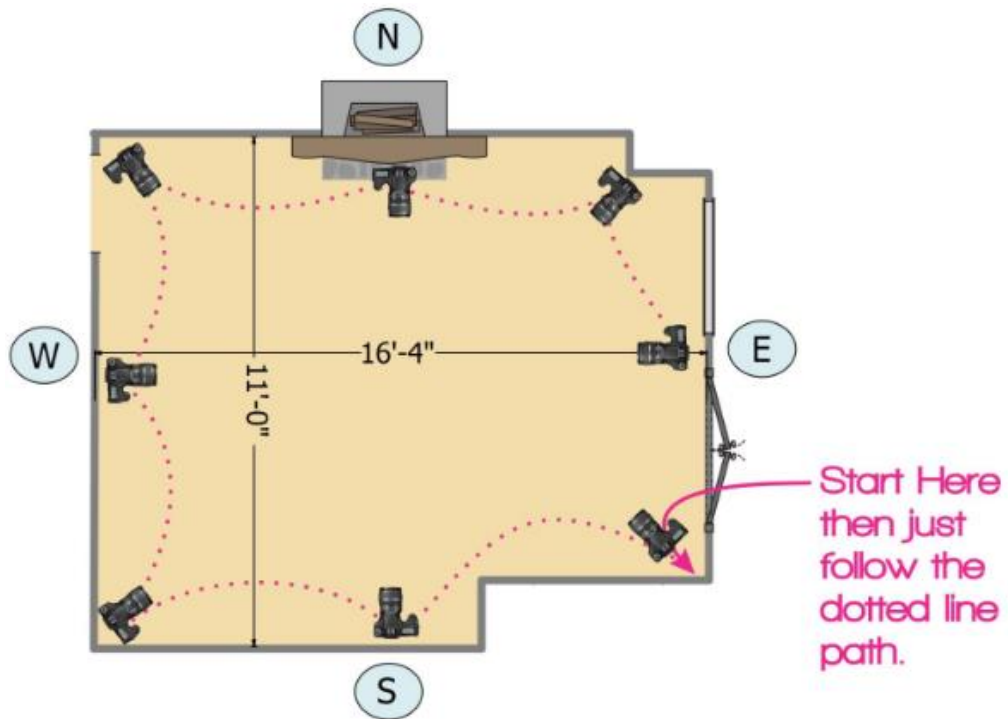
Step 4 Draw Small Things

- Draw the small things that are important like light switches, power points, wall vents, light fittings, etc.

Please repeat steps 2, 3 and 4 for each wall.



Photographing Your Space



- Tips
 - Take photos during the day
 - Turn on all the lights
 - Remove stuff and junk
 - Try first with no flash
 - Try different orientations (vertical, horizontal)
 - Send your best pictures
 - Don't be afraid to ask questions!
